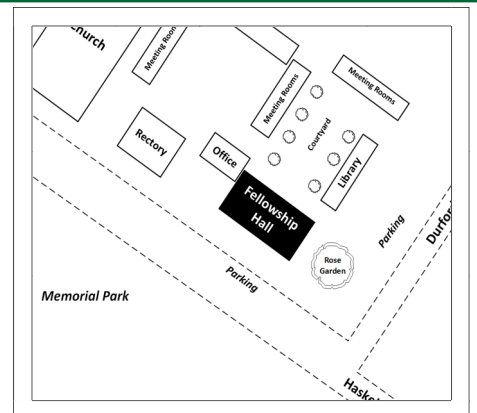
## All-Neighborhood Meeting is October 20, 7pm !

## The Status of Memorial Park

The first phases of the Master Plan are starting to be implemented. In a recent meeting, the Conservancy, TIRZ, and City representatives, indicated two parts of the plan are to start this year: 1) a water pipeline next to Crestwood, and 2) the movement of the east loop road to within about 250' of Crestwood.

Surveying for the pipeline was conducted earlier this year, and

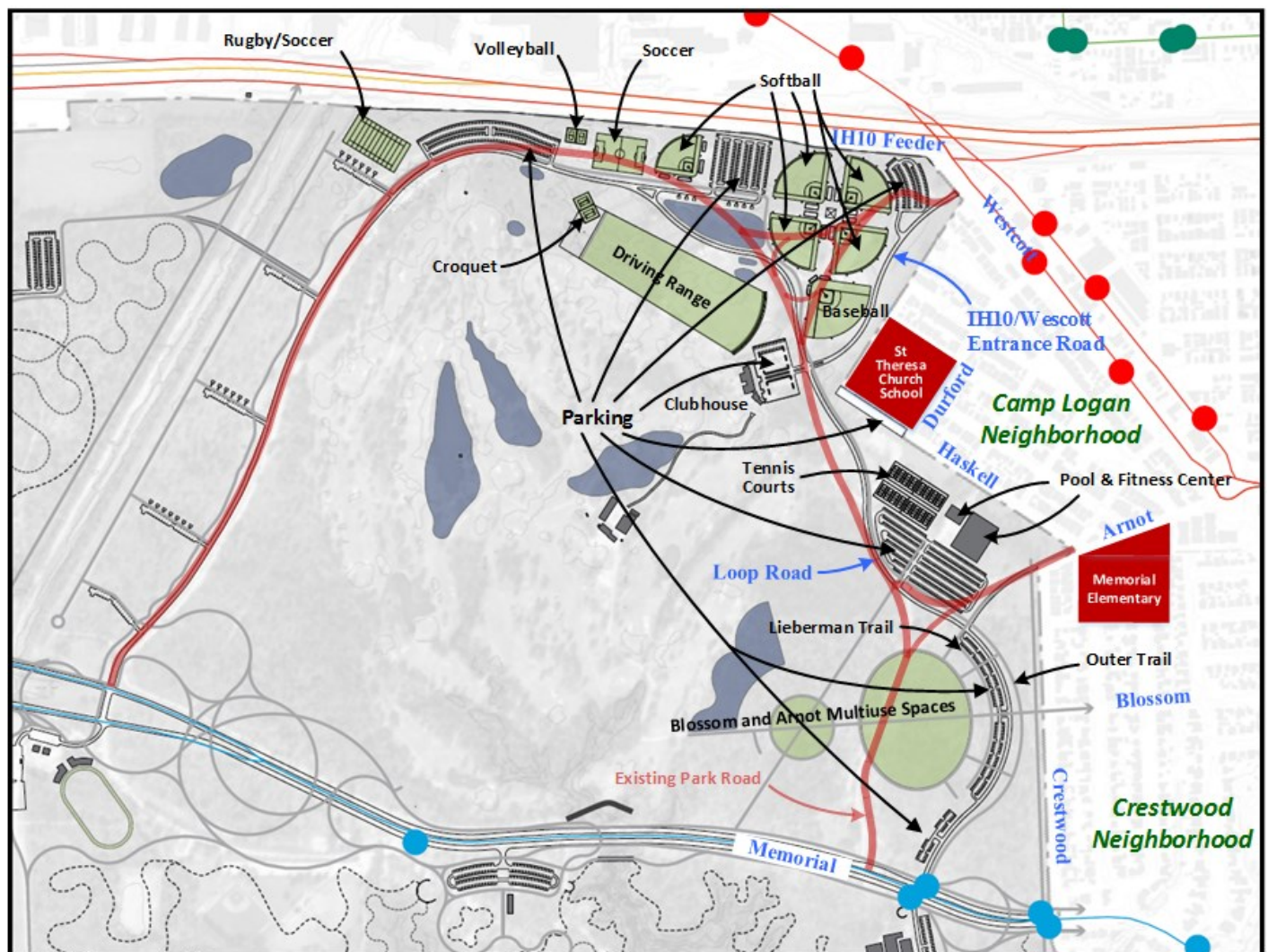
crews are now starting to use herbicides to remove vegetation from the park adjacent to Crestwood. This is to allow survey crews to layout the new path of the loop road. Tree removal could begin soon after the survey is completed. These activities are being funded by \$9.5M of TIRZ budget approved by City Council in January.

Another topic discussed in the recent meeting was the possible conversion of one lane of Blossom into a dedicated pedestrian and bike lane. This would make Blossom a one-way street.

## Chapter 42 Status

All blocks north of Memorial have minimum lot size designations if effect with two exceptions. The 500 block of Crestwood, the north side of Memorial, between Terrace and Glenwood have applications being drafted. If you live on an affected property, you will be contacted by a club member to discuss the applications.
